

## THE PERSE LOYALTY CARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The card is not a credit, debit or cheque guarantee card.

The Perse Loyalty Card is valid for use at any of the participating retailers whose details can be found on our website [www.perse.co.uk/loyalty](http://www.perse.co.uk/loyalty) from time to time.

Perse Loyalty Cards are available exclusively to members of the Perse community and are available upon request from The Perse School by contacting us at [alumni@perse.co.uk](mailto:alumni@perse.co.uk). All cards are issued by and remain the property of The Perse School which reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to decline to issue or withdraw the Loyalty Card at any time.

The Perse Loyalty Card is for personal use only and may be used by the person to whom the card is issued and members of their family.

Any special offers made by any participating retailer may be changed or withdrawn at any time by the participating retailer without prior notice. (The Perse School will aim (without obligation) to update any change in or withdrawal of special offers on its website within 2 working days of notification by the participating retailer but The Perse School shall have no responsibility or liability in relation to any special offer that may be changed or withdrawn).

To qualify for the special offer being promoted by the participating retailer, the Loyalty Card user must present the Loyalty Card at the time of purchase or enter the promotional code required when buying online and cannot be applied or claimed retrospectively. The purchase of goods or services from the participating retailer remains subject to the normal terms and conditions of the participating retailer and the participating retailer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to refuse to accept the Loyalty Card.

The Loyalty Card may only be used once per transaction and cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer, scheme or discount, unless previously agreed with the participating retailer.

Special offers have no monetary value and are non-refundable and cannot be exchanged for gift vouchers or cash.

Additional or replacements cards may be issued upon request to The Perse School, which retains the right to refuse these requests without explanation.

The Perse School reserves the right to at any time stop issuing Loyalty Cards and/or to amend these terms and conditions and/or to suspend or terminate The Perse Loyalty Card Scheme at any time on reasonable notice. If the Scheme is terminated (for whatever the reason) the Loyalty Card user loses the right to use the Loyalty Card and benefit from any special offers included within the Scheme.
